

National Statement by Amb. Bilal Ahmad, Permanent Representative, during Side Event on the Situation in Occupied Palestine Territory 12 December 2023

Honorable Foreign Ministers, Excellencies, Distinguished Participants,

I take this opportunity to convey my Government's deep appreciation for the initiatives taken by the esteemed committee to implement the Riyadh consensus of the Extraordinary Arab-Islamic Summit.

As the seat of international human rights and humanitarian law, your presence here and participation in the UDHR anniversary have amplified the cause of oppressed people of Palestine and the just pursuit for realizing their inalienable rights.

Pakistan has unequivocally stood by the brotherly people of Palestine.

During the pledging session yesterday, the Foreign Minister of Pakistan renewed our pledge to continue to lend political, moral, and diplomatic support to the brave peoples of occupied Palestine and Jammu & Kashmir.

We reaffirm our solidarity with the people of Palestine and call for an early establishment of a viable, secure, contiguous and sovereign state of Palestine on the basis of the pre-June 1967 borders and with Al-Quds Al-Sharif as its capital.
