



National Statement, delivered by Ambassador Zaman Mehdi, Deputy Permanent Representative of Pakistan, during the 3rd UPR Review of Thailand

Madam President,

We thank Thailand for presenting its 3rd UPR report and appreciate its efforts to strengthen national human rights framework in compliance with international human rights obligations.

We welcome the adoption of 4th National Human Rights Plan as well as National Plan on Business and Human Rights. It demonstrates Thailand's commitment to build national capacities and address human rights challenges in cross cutting areas.

We commend Thailand's efforts to promote and protect human rights especially ensuring access to Universal Health Coverage including affordable health services for migrant workers during COVID pandemic.

We recommend Thailand to:

- Continue its cooperation with Human Rights Council and its mechanisms including the Special Procedures.
