National Statement, delivered by Ambassador Tahir Hussain Andrabi, Deputy Permanent Representative, during the 3rd UPR of Libya

(11 November 2020)

Madam President,

Pakistan welcomes the delegation of Libya to its 3rd UPR report. We commend the resolve of the brotherly people of Libya to safeguard and promote human rights, despite political and security challenges in the country.

We also note efforts towards finalization of the Constitution as well as ensuring transitional justice and national reconciliation.

It is encouraging to note that despite challenges, Libya is making efforts for socio-economic uplift including through employment generation; improving literacy rate and providing health facilities. We hope Libya would be able to overcome multiple obstacles in achieving the desired results in the field of human rights, development and rule of law.
