

National Statement, delivered by Amb. Bilal Ahmed, during the 4th UPR of <u>China</u> 45th Session of UPR 23 January 2024

Mr. President,

Pakistan warmly welcomes the delegation of China and thanks it for presenting a comprehensive national report.

We commend China for protecting and promoting human rights, especially the unprecedented success in lifting 800 million people out of poverty and developing the world's largest education, health care, and social security systems. These are unparalleled achievements.
