Statement by Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC)

Interactive Dialogue with the Special Rapporteur on sale and sexual exploitation of children
March 2, 2020

Madam President,

On behalf of OIC, I thank the Special Rapporteur for her presentation.

Islam laid the architecture of human rights-based society where interests of the vulnerable and disadvantaged were secured through codification of rights and responsibilities. Teachings of Islam urge due care of children and grant them full rights and require that all children, girls and boys alike, have the right to live in dignity and thrive to reach their full potential¹.

The OIC countries believe that every child has the right to a full and productive life. It is essential that all States take steps to ensure that every child grows up in an environment that builds confidence, well-being, happiness and security².

Child rights are threatened by persistence of poverty, inadequate social and economic conditions, pandemics, communicable and non-communicable diseases, climate change, natural disasters, armed conflicts, foreign occupation, displacement, violence, terrorism, abuse, communalism, discrimination, and inadequate legal protection in different parts of the world³.

Madam President,

The OIC countries reaffirm their commitment to ensure protection of children, prevention of their exploitation and provision of an enabling environment for their physical and psychological wellbeing⁴.

We request the Special Rapporteur to elaborate how the situation of children living under foreign occupation makes them vulnerable to sale and sexual exploitation and what measures can the international community and the UN human rights machinery can undertake to alleviate their situation.
