

National Statement, delivered by Permanent Representative, Ambassador Khalil Hashmi, during the 4th UPR Review of Indonesia (41st Session of UPR) 9 November 2022

Mr. President,

We warmly welcome and thank the delegation of Indonesia for presentation of its 4^{th} UPR report.

We appreciate Indonesia's cooperation with the UN human rights mechanisms and advancement of its human rights agenda through various legislative and policy initiatives, such as the Protection of Indonesian Migrant Workers Law, Corruption Eradication Commission Law, Sexual Violence Crime Law and the new iteration of National Action Plan on Human Rights.

We have the following recommendations:

- Continued prioritization of health and safety in tandem with economic recovery efforts, post covid-19 pandemic;
- Expansion of projects aimed at enhancing women's empowerment in entrepreneurship; and
- Continue human rights related awareness raising and capacity building efforts among relevant stakeholders, especially law enforcement officials.

We wish Indonesia a successful review.
